Safety Car Requirements

2017 Edition 3 Stage Rally Safety Requirements

- 2.11.1 All Safety Car Crew Members must have undertaken the on-line marshal accreditation modules.
- 2.11.2 At least one member of each safety car team for the whole event must have attended part one of the MSA Safety Car Training Session.
- 2.11.3 By **01-01-18** At least one member of each safety car crew must have attended one of the MSA Safety Car workshops.
- 2.11.4 Those operating safety cars do not need to hold a competition license – they must however have safety experience *and by 2018 one member of each vehicle must have attended the Safety Car workshop.*
- 2.11.7 *Parts one and two of the Safety Car Workshop have now been combined, elements of part two will be incorporated into part one. This single day will be the mandatory day. Further Driver Awareness days may be available in the future.*

Applications and Registration

- Applications will only be accepted from events via Clerk of the Course nominations
- Each CoC will be able to nominate individuals from their safety car teams to attend the programmes. *These individuals must be expected to be part of the Safety Car team during 2017 or 2018.*
- Once nominated, each individual Clerk will be sent a link to forward to their nominees which will provide them with the ability to access and complete the registration form where they will select their dates.
- Registration will be available for those who have completed the on-line accreditation and have registered with the MSA.
- Registrations for each date will close 2 weeks prior to the workshop OR when the workshop is full.
- Once the registration is completed, delegates will receive their joining instructions along with maps and further information about whether they are to attend the driver awareness or event safety section first.
