

# 2018 MSA BRITISH SPORTING TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIP



## 1. ANNOUNCEMENT

1.1 The Championship will be run under the General Regulations of the MSA and these Regulations. Where any difference occurs between the General Regulations and these Regulations, these Regulations will take precedence. Waiver of Permit 2018/S/0500 has been issued.

## 2. CARS ELIGIBLE

2.1 The Championship is open to drivers of cars complying with the National Trials Car Formula, as published in the MSA Competitors' Yearbook, Section T12.1 – T12.12.1 of the Regulations, for 2018.

2.2 Permitted tyres are listed in Section L List 3 of the 2018 MSA Competitors' Yearbook.

## 3. SCORING

3.1 Points will be awarded from 1st place overall to 15th place overall with the winner receiving 15 points, second place 14 points, and so on down to 15th place who will receive 1 point.

3.2 Events to count in deciding the Championship will be in accordance with paragraph 3.3 and 3.4 below.

3.4 In the event of a tie between two or more competitors the better discarded result will continue to be counted until a result is obtained. If a tie still exists the number of best places will be counted. Should neither of these methods be effective the competitor who gained his Championship points first will be deemed the winner. Should none of these methods be effective the MSA will specify the method to reach a solution.

3.5 For 2018 the MSA British Sporting Trials Championship will include the **MSA Live Axle Trophy**. This will awarded to the highest placed driver of a trials car with a live axle that is not eligible for another award in the year end classification. Articles 3.1 to 3.4 apply.

## 4. ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS

4.1 Any holder of a 2018 Competition Licence issued by either the MSA or Motor Sport Ireland.

## 5. REGISTRATION

5.1 Competitors will not be required to register for the Championship. Participating in a Championship round entitles the competitor to score points.

## 6. QUALIFYING EVENTS

6.1 Please see page 2 for qualifying events.

6.2 In the event of a qualifying round not proceeding as scheduled through force majeure, for example prevailing ground conditions, the organisers may re-arrange the event on a new date suitable to the championship.

## 7. DECALS

7.1 Championship decals will be available at all rounds and in order to score points all competing cars at each round must carry two decals per car, one on either side.
